**Please note:** You must apply for admission to Sussex County Community College before submitting this application. If your application is incomplete, it will not be considered.

#### A complete application packet will include:

Honors Program application (see back)
High school and/or college transcripts indicating at least a 3.5 GPA (on a 4.0 scale)
or a 3.94 (on a 4.5 scale)
Please provide any relevant test scores for SAT and/or ACT test
A letter of recommendation from a guidance counselor, teacher/professor or
someone who can address your preparedness for a rigorous program of study
Required essay (see below) or résumé and/or list of achievements including awards,
scholarships, and membership in clubs and other organizations. The Honors Program
admissions committee may also request an interview

**Required essay:** Write an essay of 500-800 words on ONE of the following topics:

- What is the value and importance of community service in our society? What does it mean to you?
- In your opinion, what is the greatest challenge your generation faces? What ideas do you have for dealing with this issue?
- What is the greatest challenge you have personally faced?
  How did you deal with that issue and would you change anything if you could?
