For the purposes of this budget, it is proposed that the tuition/fees for in-county and veterans for FY2016-2017 change from \$130 to \$145 per credit hour. It is proposed that tuition for out of county, Monroe, Pike & Wayne County, PA change from \$195 to \$218 per credit hour. It is proposed that out of state-resident-USA, except as noted above, change from \$260 to \$290 per credit hour. It is proposed that tuition for international students change from \$260 to \$363 per credit hour. Fees will change as per the chart below.

The College will request the County to provide the Go-Bond match in the amount of \$1,450,000 for bonding in FY2017. The Go-Bond request was previously approved the Board of School Estimate on March 28, 2014.
