503.3 Early College Advantage Programs (ECAP)

PURPOSE OF THE POLICY

Sussex County Community College (SCCC) provides qualifying high school and/or homeschooled students, the opportunity to earn college credits. SCCC offers two different types of programs under this policy: Jumpstart and Concurrent.

GENERAL STATEMENT OF EARLY COLLEGE ADVANTAGE PROGRAMS

Sussex County Community College will allow qualifying high school and/or homeschooled students an opportunity to take in-person and/or online courses. At the request of SCCC, students may be required to:

- Meet with SCCC Academic Affairs personnel,
- Demonstrate proof of meeting specified academic requirements as established by the College in order to participate in these programs,
- Have signed permission from a parent or legal guardian, and/or
- Have a signed recommendation letter from a high school guidance counselor.

Students participating in these programs must adhere to all policies, rules, and regulations governing their peer, non-ECAP participants, established by the college or mandated by state, local, and/or federal guidelines.
