Thank you for your interest in Sussex County Community College's Student Ambassador Program for the Fall 2021 semester. While this is a very competitive application process the friends, memories, and leadership skills you will gain make this process well worth it! Campus Life and SCCC thank you in advance for your commitment.

Skylander Student Ambassadors assist with various activities, recruitment and public relations events, and they serve as student mentors to new students. Skylander Student Ambassadors have the opportunity to work with Staff and Faculty in all departments throughout the college, and gain valuable skills along the way.

In addition to assisting as an SCCC representative in the community, you will also have the opportunity to spend the semester working with Campus Life and the Student Government Association in planning and executing campus events and activities. Highlights for the Fall 2021 semester include the **New Student Orientation**, Welcome Back Weeks, Homecoming, & Monte Carlo Night!

As a Skylander Student Ambassador, you will have an opportunity to develop valuable leadership skills, which will serve you when you graduate from SCCC and transfer to a four-year school or enter the workforce. Campus Life has high expectations for Skylander Student Ambassadors and that means whether you are running the popcorn machine at an Open Mic or presenting to our Board of Trustees, we expect you to conduct yourself professionally, while still having a great time. Campus Life is committed to helping you develop the leadership skills needed to become a top student leader at SCCC and beyond!

Being a SCCC Skylander Student Ambassador is a job, just like any other job, but it is also FUN! Ambassadors are required to complete a minimum of 40, 60, or 80 hours by the end of the Fall 2021 semester. As you are considering becoming an Ambassador, think about your schedule and other obligations and take the time to consider which option works best for you. Campus Life accepts ALL schedules, so if you are interested there is an option that is the perfect fit for you.

Each Ambassador will receive a work grant applied to their SCCC account during the semester of service. A 40-hour Ambassador earns an \$840.00 work grant, a 60-hour Ambassador earns a \$1,260.00 work grant, and an 80-hour Ambassador earns a\$1,680.00 work grant.

If being a Skylander Student Ambassador is the right fit for you, **WE CAN'T WAIT TO HEAR FROM YOU!** Simply follow these steps:

- 1. Complete the attached application.
- 2. Obtain a written recommendation letter from a faculty or staff member. Have the letter of recommendation emailed to <u>arude@sussex.edu</u> <u>NOLATER THAN MONDAY</u>, <u>APRIL 12, 2021</u>.
- 3. Submit a typed essay (essay topics are located at the end of the application). Remember to put your best foot forward, check spelling, grammar, and punctuation!
- 4. Submit your application along with the supplemental documents to Amy Rude at <u>arude@sussex.edu</u> NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, APRIL 9, 2021.
- 5. Due to the COVID-19 regulations, personal interviews will be scheduled both in-person and via ZOOM during the week of April 19th-22nd. This is the opportunity to WOW the selection committee, so make sure to bring your "A" game!

<u>If you are currently receiving or are planning to apply for Financial Aid, it is critical that</u> you contact the office of Financial Aid as soon as possible to ensure you will not affect your eligibility for aid by being selected as a Skylander Student Ambassador.

The following outlines each graded category and what the selection committee will be looking at/for in each.

<u>Application Time/Effort:</u> Candidate took the time to follow directions, all information is organized, professional, and formatted.

<u>Application Complete:</u> Application is intact with all pages/questions, each section is filled out with info or N/A, reference was listed, and applicant was registered for fall 2021 during priority registration.

<u>Application Content:</u> Responses to questions are well thought out and complete, student shows interest in the leadership experience, demonstrates understanding of the program, and articulates a desire to be a Skylander Student Ambassador and have an impact on student engagement and school spirit that goes beyond financial benefits of the program.

<u>Personal Essay:</u> Response is well thought out and addresses the specific question asked. The essay is been proofread, well organized, and detail rich.

<u>Recommendation Letter</u>: Includes how long and in what capacity the Recommender knows the Applicant and what contributions to the program that the Recommender feels the Applicant will make to the Skylander Student Ambassador program.

<u>Interview:</u> Each Applicant will participate in a personal interview with a panel of Interviewers from across the College. The Applicant Interview score is the average of all Interviewers.
