Financial aid regulations state that dependent students are required to complete the parental sections, provide parental income information, and parental signatures on the FAFSA to be considered for financial aid. You may request a review to waive the federal regulation requirement if you can document that you are separated from your parents due to an abusive environment or extraordinary circumstances.

- Under Federal Regulations your parent's unwillingness to provide their information, your ability to support yourself, or the fact that you do not live with your parents DOES NOT constitute a reason for a Dependency Override to be approved.

Please provide a separate letter which includes a brief history describing the circumstances which has caused you to request a dependency status review. The following questions should be answered in your letter.

1. Where are both of your parents located? 2. When and where was the last time, you had contact with each of your parents and what was the nature of the contact? 3. How have you been self-supporting? When did you start meeting your expenses without

parental support?
